- **Cancer Prevention Laurel for Advocacy:** Awarded to someone whose personal passion for improving cancer prevention or early detection has resulted in positive change in the public, professional or political arena.
- **Cancer Prevention Laurel for Dedication to Community Service:** Awarded to someone who has demonstrated unwavering commitment to enhancing cancer prevention or early detection on the community level.
