You must be:

- Male
- Between the ages of 55-59
- U.S. resident

You will be asked to:

- Come to an appointment in the Texas Medical Center (*parking costs covered*)
- Sign an informed consent document
- Complete a questionnaire
- Provide a blood and saliva sample
